Pumpkin Terracotta
Lasch

History: Owner has noticed some limping for few weeks, mostly right hind. Reluctant to jump for few months.

RADIOGRAPHIC STUDY OF THE STIFLES

SPECIES

Feline

The skin surfaces are smooth and the muscles appear to be symmetrically developed.

All bones are well mineralized, have a normal trabecular structure and a smooth surface. Cortical-medullary development and differentiation of the long bones are physiological.

BREED

DMH

Both stifle joints have smooth subchondral bone surfaces and the centre of the femoral condyles is in line with the intercondylar eminence. The cranial fat pad has a physiological size and the caudal fascial plains are in a physiological position; a circular calcification is located in the region of the cranial meniscus. New bone formation is not evident and the patellae appear to be located in their respective groove.

RADIOGRAPHIC DIAGNOSIS

- Bilateral, localized calcification cranial meniscal region

AGE

3 Years

INTERPRETATION OF THE FINDINGS & FURTHER RECOMMENDATIONS

Calcification in the feline stifle joint is not unusual and thus is not necessarily a sign of a disease process. A reluctance to jump could be due to spinal disease, e.g. disc protrusion, and a neurological examination may have to be followed by cross sectional imaging.
