



PATIENT PRESENTING CLINICAL SIGNS

Oreo Valentin History: Pt presented for bloody diarrhea and vomiting that has been going on for 2-3 days. Pt presented at emergency hospital about a month ago with similar symptoms - was given metron and panacur and diarrhea/vomiting completely resolved until 2-3 days ago. Pt not as interested in eating, but drinking/urinating normally. NOSF on PE today. cbc/chem/cpl pending.

SPECIES RADIOGRAPHIC STUDY OF THE ABDOMEN

Canine The body condition score is 7/9 with smooth alternating layers of fat and soft tissue opacity.

BREED One multipartide fabella is present in the more caudally positioned stifle.

Maltese The abdominal detail is good; diaphragm and abdominal wall are intact.

SEX The stomach contains a moderate amount of air; duodenum and a cranial jejunal (SI) loop contain gas are slightly distended with gas. Distribution and size of the other small intestinal loops appear physiological. Ascending colon and cecum are not readily seen. The dec. colon contains a physiological amount of gas.

Neutered Male

AGE The other abdominal organs appear physiological.

3.5 Years RADIOGRAPHIC DIAGNOSIS

- Mild, localized ileus
- Multipartide fabella (incidental finding)

INTERPRETATION OF THE FINDINGS & FURTHER RECOMMENDATIONS

The mild ileus may be due to increased motility or could be the result of a mechanical, partial obstruction. Abdominal ultrasound is recommended to assess intestinal wall thickness and layering as well as diameter. A radiolucent foreign object may be visible. Alternatively, the radiographs should be repeated to see if the gas filled loops are still in the same position.
