Chloe Ricard History: Chief Complaint: CHECK RH History: ABOUT 2 AND 1/2 WEEKS AGO, P WAS LIMPING FROM RH ,GOTTEN BETTER BUT WHEN P IS PLAYING TOO MUCH OR O SON HUGS HER P LETS OUT A YELP, THE OTHER DAY P WAS LIMPING AGAIN, STILL SEEMS TO FAVOR THE RIGHT HIND AND P SEEMED TO SLOW DOWN, O IS MASSAGE +NAILS

SPECIES

Canine Abnormal PE/Chem/CBC/UA Results: Musculoskeletal: BCS = 5/9. Ambulatory x 4 with weight-bearing right pelvic limb lameness. Severe pain on right hip extension. No other abnormalities on orthopedic exam

BREED RADIOGRAPHIC STUDY OF PELVIS AND RIGHT STIFLE

Miniature Poodle The muscle mass of the right hind leg is reduced.

Age-related skeletal immaturity is noted.

SEX

Spayed Female The skeletal structures are well mineralized, with physiological cortico-medullary development and differentiation.

Pelvis

AGE

9 Months The right femoral head shows a radiolucent line extending from the center of the joint surface through the physis, into the metaphysis; an extension to the metaphyseal surface is not obvious. The line has a width of 0.15 cm and a length of 0.8 cm. The articular surface of the femoral head shows a small step. No new bone formation is evident.

Right Stifle

INTERPRETED BY

Heike Rudolf, DVM, Dr. med. Vet., DipECVDDI DVR The stifle joint has smooth subchondral bone surfaces and the centre of the femoral condyles is in line with the intercondylar eminence. The cranial fat pad has a physiological size and the caudal fascial plains appear to be in a physiological position. New bone formation is not evident and the patella is located in its groove.

INTERPRETATION OF THE FINDINGS & FURTHER RECOMMENDATIONS

The fracture line is compatible with a variation of the SH type 4 fracture because the metaphyseal termination appears to be within the metaphysis and the fragment is in place. Obtaining a VD frog leg view is necessary to assess the changes in a different plain. Consulting an orthopedic surgeon is recommended to decide on the type of treatment.
