



PATIENT PRESENTING CLINICAL SIGNS

Chloe Ferreira History: Noted p favoring left hind leg yesterday - appears to carry leg lower than right hind. e/d, u/d ok. Per o has never been a jumper, will not jump from high up.

SPECIES Abnormal PE/Chem/CBC/UA Results: discomfort on extension of left hind , p did lose 2 lbs.

RADIOGRAPHIC STUDY OF THE PELVIS

The skin surfaces are smooth, and the muscles appear to be symmetrically developed.

BREED

All bones are well mineralized, have a normal trabecular structure and a smooth surface. Cortical-medullary development and differentiation of the long bones are physiological.

DSH

SEX

The centre of both femoral heads is located medial to the respective dorsal acetabular edge. Both hip joints appear congruent with even subchondral bone surfaces. No new bone formation is evident. A soft tissue swelling is present on the lateral aspect of the left stifle joint which is not evident on the right.

- Soft tissue swelling lateral L stifle joint

INTERPRETATION OF THE FINDINGS & FURTHER RECOMMENDATIONS

The changes could be due to trauma (hematoma, synovial cyst), infection, inflammation or represent a soft tissue tumour (e.g. synovial cell sarcoma, fibrosarcoma). The latter is, however, rare in cats. Further examination of this region with palpation, possible comparative ultrasound and sampling is recommended.
