Harlan Giannini History: noted swelling on right hind a couple of weeks ago. Per o improved after starting abx but now appears more swollen, just finished 2 week course of abx last night. P did chew at paw last night
 Abnormal PE/Chem/CBC/UA Results: soft swelling on right hind tarsus, fluid filled. Awaiting culture and cytology results

SPECIES

Canine

RADIOGRAPHIC STUDY OF THE RIGHT HIND PAW

Soft tissue swelling is present on the medial aspect of digit 2 between metacarpus and P2. On the lateral view the swelling appears to be entirely located on the dorsal aspect of the distal metacarpus and is approx. 3cm long and 2cm deep.

BREED

Border Collie

The bones are well mineralized, have a normal trabecular structure and smooth, continuous surfaces. Cortical-medullary development and differentiation of the long bones are physiological.

SEX

RADIOGRAPHIC DIAGNOSIS

Neutered Male

- Circumscribed soft tissue mass dorsal to metacarpus

INTERPRETATION OF THE FINDINGS & FURTHER RECOMMENDATIONS

AGE

6 Years

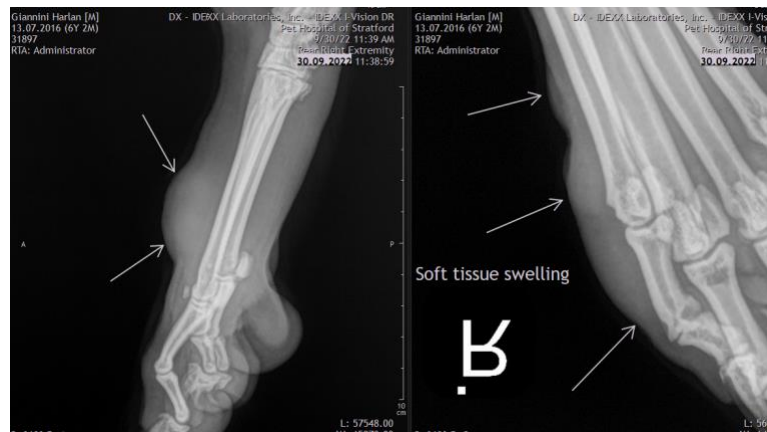
The swelling/mass could be due to a foreign body abscess, hemorrhage due to trauma, fibroma/fibrosarcoma. Depending on the results of histology and bacteriology, the treatment may have to progress to surgery.
