



PATIENT	PRESENTING CLINICAL SIGNS
Puff Phillips	Vomiting after eating since last night (9/7/2021). No pain with palpation of the abdomen. Lab results pending.
SPECIES	RADIOGRAPHIC STUDY OF THE ABDOMEN
Feline	RLR, LLR, 2x VD
BREED	RADIOGRAPHIC FINDINGS
DMH	The body condition score is 8/9 with smooth alternating layers of fat and soft tissue opacity. The bones are well mineralized with good trabecular structure and smooth surfaces. The disc spaces appear homogeneous in width.
SEX	The region between head of spleen, stomach and left kidney has a slightly striated appearance; the abdominal detail is otherwise good.
Spayed	The liver is located within the costal arch and the caudo-ventral lobe is pointed.
AGE	The spleen appears physiological.
2 Years	The stomach contains a moderate amount of air; the small intestinal loops occupy the central abdomen and appear of homogeneous and physiological size. Colon and rectum contain a small amount of fecal matter and some gas.
INTERPRETED BY	Both renal shadows have a physiological size, shape and opacity. The bladder is located in the abdominal cavity and contains a moderate amount of homogeneous fluid opacity.

REFERRING VET	INTERPRETATION OF THE FINDINGS & FURTHER RECOMMENDATIONS
Sareena Enloe, DVM	I can see no signs of foreign body or intestinal obstruction. Pancreatitis, dietary indiscretion, imbibed toxins (e.g. plant material) or viral gastro-enteritis are possible causes.
INVOICE	The localized reduction in abdominal detail may be an artefact due to slight respiratory movement but could be due to pancreatitis. Abdominal ultrasound can help identify pancreatic enlargement and will allow assessment of GIT wall size and layering.
