The cranial thorax is evaluated. The region of the cranial mediastinum appears normal with a small amount of fat. No identifiable mass lesions are observed and there is no evidence of any pleural effusion or significant lymphadenopathy. There are occasional subtle “B-lines” noted, and the visualized regions of the cardiac silhouette appear within normal limits (no obvious effusion or mass lesions).

**INTERPRETATION OF THE FINDINGS & FURTHER RECOMMENDATIONS**

**WEIGHT**

No mass lesion is observed on today’s exam. Subtle “B-lines” are observed, which can be sometimes seen with congestion, mild pulmonary parenchymal disease, etc. Correlate with patient’s thoracic radiographs and clinical history.

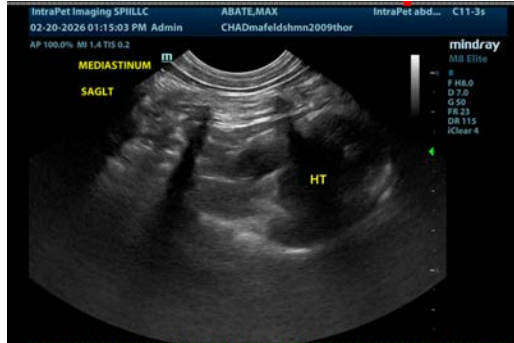
