PRESENTING CLINICAL SIGNS

Vomiting and not eating, concerned about a foreign body

The submitted study contained 9 still images and 2 videos, primarily of the cranial abdomen / upper gastrointestinal tract

LIMITED ULTRASONOGRAPHIC EXAMINATION

The stomach presented an overtly normal intact visible wall. The stomach exhibited moderate distention with retained anechoic fluid.

A strongly shadowing echo was present in the subjective upper to mid-duodenum, measuring ~2.5 cm in diameter. Distal duodenum and visible cranial abdomen small intestine exhibited overtly normal intact wall layering and empty lumen.

Subjective mild increased perigastric omental echogenicity was noted. There was no visualized peritoneal effusion or overt lymphadenopathy.

The visualized liver and gallbladder were sonographically normal.

ULTRASONOGRAPHIC FINDINGS

- Fluid-distended stomach with subjective duodenal foreign body

INTERPRETATION OF THE FINDINGS & FURTHER RECOMMENDATIONS

Exploratory laparotomy with gross inspection of the gastrointestinal tract, potential manual manipulation of the foreign body back into the stomach with gastrotomy vs. enterotomy is recommended.
