



PATIENT PRESENTING CLINICAL SIGNS

Ozzie Bruno Slightly elevated thyroid

SPECIES ULTRASONOGRAPHIC EXAMINATION OF THE THYROID

Canine The left thyroid lobe was normal in size, symmetry and echogenicity, measuring 2.3 cm in length x 0.43 cm in width.

BREED The right thyroid lobe exhibited subtle thickened presentation compared to the left thyroid lobe with subtle capsule asymmetry, yet homogeneous, isoechoic parenchyma compared to the left thyroid lobe, and without evidence of overt massessor nodules, measuring 2.1 cm length x 0.66 cm in width.

ULTRASONOGRAPHIC FINDINGS

SEX

Neutered Male

- Normal left thyroid lobe
- Mild prominent to subtle irregular yet homogeneous right thyroid lobe – no overt neoplastic criteria.

INTERPRETATION OF THE FINDINGS & FURTHER RECOMMENDATIONS

The sonographic presentation of the mildly prominent right thyroid lobe compared to the left is of unclear clinical significant, yet not overtly suggestive of neoplastic criteria. Full thyroid panel to include T4, free T4 and TSH levels could be considered if not done. Assessment for any potential diets or supplements that could potentially effect T4 levels suggested. Given the young age of the patient, and without obvious left or right thyroid lobe pathology, continued monitoring of T4 trends with sonographic reassessment, specifically of the right thyroid lobe pending additional monitoring, would be reasonable.
