April Roe History: No murmur or arrhythmia. Vulva appears to be starting to swell. Stenotic nares. Soft, non-painful abdomen. tied about 2-3 weeks ago

**SPECIES ULTRASONOGRAPHIC PREGNANCY CHECK**

Canine

**BREED**

French Bulldog

Sonographic assessment of the uterus revealed viable fetuses exhibiting normal fetal blood flow on color Doppler assessment. Normal appearing early gravid uterus was observed. Adjacent segments of small intestine and colon appear to be sonographically normal. No evidence of peritoneal free fluid.

- Confirmed pregnancy with viable fetuses-at least 2 visualized, potential estimate for 2-3 fetuses at this stage

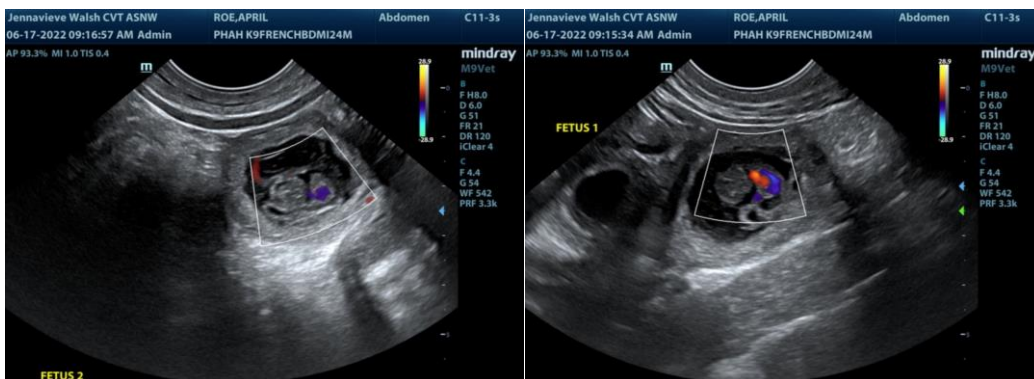
