PRESENTING CLINICAL SIGNS

Acute onset non weight bearing RH. Was fine last night and woke up this morning and could not walk. 100% indoor cat.

Abnormal PE/Chem/CBC/UA Results: NWB RH. Temperature normal. Soft tissue swelling palpated at level of lateral femur.

SPECIES

Feline

RADIOGRAPHIC STUDY OF THE RIGHT STIFLE

Mediolateral view of the right stifle and ventrodorsal hip extended view of the pelvis totaling 2 images available for review.

BREED

DLH

RADIOGRAPHIC FINDINGS

The radiographic presentation of the right stifle joint is within normal limits. There is no evidence of articular swelling or other articular changes. The joint is in situ. No evidence of patella luxation is seen. There is no evidence of osteoarthritic changes.

SEX

FS

The soft tissue shadow of the right hind limb is wider than the soft tissue shadow of the left hind; however, the positioning is not entirely symmetric between the right and left hind limb.

AGE

8 Years

Both coxofemoral joints present within normal limits.

The femurs and the pelvis present within normal limits.

RADIOGRAPHIC DIAGNOSIS

- No evidence of osseous or articular injury in the right hind / right stifle.
- Presumed soft tissue swelling in the right thigh.
