Acute RH lameness, possibly slipped on ice, NWB to toe touching lame RH, painful on extension of RH stifle. Suspect patella avulsed? r/o STT vs other

RADIOGRAPHIC STUDY OF THE STIFLES

Mediolateral and craniocaudal views of the right and left stifle totaling 8 images available for review.

BREED

Coonhound

RADIOGRAPHIC FINDINGS

No evidence of articular swelling or cranial thrust of the tibia is seen in either of the stifle joints. The patella appears to be in situ in all available images. There is no evidence of periarticular or articular soft tissue swelling.

SEX

MN

The patella ligament presents thin and smooth in both stifles.

Small cartilage remnants are present in the tibial tuberosity in both hind limbs which is considered incidental.

AGE

2 Years

Note the presence of bilateral hip dysplasia.

RADIOGRAPHIC DIAGNOSIS

- Radiographically normal stifle joints.

INTERPRETATION OF THE FINDINGS & FURTHER RECOMMENDATIONS

No evidence of osseous or articular injury of the stifle joints is seen radiographically. The patella ligaments and patellae present within normal limits.
