History of jumping off snow bank and face planting with R PL lameness. Stiffness in thoracic and lumbar spine. Check hips and knees also. Difficulties getting in/out of car and walking on uneven surfaces.

Lateral and ventrodorsal views of the thoracolumbar spine, ventrodorsal view of the pelvis, and mediolateral views of both stifles totaling 7 images available for review.

**RADIOGRAPHIC FINDINGS**

Number, alignment, and anatomy of the thoracolumbar vertebrae present within normal limits. The intervertebral disc spaces are of even width. There is no evidence of aggressive bone lesions or traumatic osseous injury.

**SEX**

The pelvic bones are bilaterally symmetric and present no deviation from their expected anatomy.

**AGE**

8 Years

The coxofemoral joints present within normal limits. No evidence of dysplasia or osteoarthritis is seen.

Both stifle joints present within normal limits. There is no evidence of articular swelling, osteoarthritis, cranial thrust of the tibia, or other.
