



PATIENT PRESENTING CLINICAL SIGNS

PATIENT Churro Lupul Severe URT congestion for 1 wk, sneezing more but no coloured discharge noted. Indoor only, no contact with other cats.

SPECIES Feline Abnormal PE/Chem/CBC/UA Results: No air flow on glass slide test. Salivating more esp on R side. Caudal to R lower premolar inflamed and grinds teeth/painful when try to examine, concern of mass present but would need to sedate to visualize. SubQ crepitus in neck area? No fever CBC-nsf Chem-hypercalcemia, 12.9 (7.8-11.3) concern of hypercalcemia of malignancy. Remainder of chem, T4 and u/a normal.

BREED RADIOGRAPHIC STUDY OF THE HEAD

BREED DLH 2 oblique views of the head available for review. The views are rotated.

RADIOGRAPHIC FINDINGS

SEX MN Multiple teeth are absent. Resorptive changes of the remaining teeth are seen.

AGE 18 Years I can neither delineate a mass nor definitive aggressive osteolytic changes in the nasal cavities, paranasal sinuses, maxillae, and mandibles.

The nasal turbinates appear to be intact.

The tympanic bullae present within normal limits.

INTERPRETED BY RADIOGRAPHIC DIAGNOSIS

- Incomplete dentition with presumed tooth root resorption and potential for periodontal disease.
- No definitive mass effect or aggressive osteolysis seen.

HOSPITAL NAME INTERPRETATION OF THE FINDINGS & FURTHER RECOMMENDATIONS

The radiographic study does not allow the diagnosis of aggressive osteolytic changes in the facial bones or the presence of a definitive soft tissue mass.

REFERRING VET

There appear to be resorptive changes of the remaining teeth which require correlation with the clinical workup.

The cause of the upper airway obstruction remains unclear; however, the relatively negative radiographic findings increase the odds of inflammatory/infectious pathology. CT and eventual endoscopy would be ideal in the further workup for this patient to further verify and define the presence of upper airway pathology.
