PRESENTING CLINICAL SIGNS

Vomited piece of Bully stick 4 days ago. Vomited two times 4 days ago and once 3 days ago, no vomit since then but still gagging. No diarrhea, no coughing. Eating well.

Abnormal PE/Chem/CBC/UA Results: Blood work in house : CBC unremarkable. Chemistry: increase in Phos 3.38 (1.6), mild increase in Cal 3.35 (3.1), otherwise unremarkable. Electrolytes normal.

RADIOGRAPHIC STUDY OF THE ABDOMEN

Right/left lateral and ventrodorsal views totaling 3 images available for review. There was a 4th Dicom file that was corrupt and cannot be read.

RADIOGRAPHIC FINDINGS

The penis bone appears to be small.

The abdominal serosal detail is still mildly reduced which is within age related normal limits.

The stomach is post-prandial.

The descending duodenum is highlighted by gas on the ventrodorsal view and appears nondilated. The small intestinal loops are seen within the mid abdomen and there is no evidence of abnormal dilation, radiopaque foreign material, or plication.

A moderate amount of fecal matter is seen in the colon.

RADIOGRAPHIC DIAGNOSIS

- Radiographically normal abdomen.

INTERPRETATION OF THE FINDINGS & FURTHER RECOMMENDATIONS

The radiographic study reveals no evidence of small intestinal ileus. No radiopaque foreign material is identified. Further definition would only be indicated in case of recurring clinical signs.
