PRESENTING CLINICAL SIGNS

Hx of chronic cough, has been diagnosed and being treated for cushings disease with vetroyl cough being treated with hycodan, temaril-P, and adequan injections. minimal response, cough is worse at night. Patient does not have a heart murmur. X-rays ordered to further investigate cough.

RADIOGRAPHIC STUDY OF THE THORAX

Right/left lateral and ventrodorsal views totaling 4 images available for review.

RADIOGRAPHIC FINDINGS

Cranial lumbar spondyloses with reduced intervertebral disc space width are seen.

SEX

A large amount of subcutaneous fat is seen.

MN

The cranial thoracic dorsal tracheal kink is thought to be positional.

AGE

15

The heart is of normal size and shape and there is no evidence of cardiac chamber or vascular enlargement. The pulmonary vasculature is within normal limits.

The cranial mediastinum presents the expected soft tissue opacity. The mediastinal width is less than twice the width of the vertebral column at the same level.

The trachea is normal in diameter and presents the anticipated course. The luminal outline of the trachea is smooth.

A moderate generalized bronchointerstitial lung pattern with peribronchial cuffing is seen.

The diaphragm is well delineated with even surface and the expected mild cranial bulging of the diaphragmatic cupola.

RADIOGRAPHIC DIAGNOSIS

- Chronic active lower airway disease.

INTERPRETATION OF THE FINDINGS & FURTHER RECOMMENDATIONS

The radiographic findings suggest presence of chronic active lower airway disease. Consider eosinophilic bronchopneumopathy a potential versus infectious bronchitis such as viral, bacterial, and less likely parasitic, or protozoal. There is no radiographic evidence of cardiovascular pathology.
