PRESENTING CLINICAL SIGNS

Limping Left rear Exam: left stifle flexion pain; mild cranial drawer
Abnormal PE/Chem/CBC/UA Results: NA

SPECIES

Canine

ULTRASONOGRAPHIC FINDINGS

Left Stifle

Mild osteophytosis is noted at the femoral trochlea. There is a mild amount of anechoic effusion within the supra- and infra-patellar recesses of the left stifle joint. Mild synovial swelling is noted.

BREED

Chi/Terrier Mix

The cranial cruciate ligament presents mild generalized swelling with slightly ill-defined margins. The ligament however is continuous and the echoarchitecture of the ligament appears to be maintained.

SEX

MN

The medial meniscus is not directly seen. No evidence of pathology is noted in the region of the medial meniscus.

ULTRASONOGRAPHIC DIAGNOSIS

- Mild left stifle osteoarthritis with suspect cranial cruciate ligament edema.

AGE

10 Years

INTERPRETATION OF THE FINDINGS & FURTHER RECOMMENDATIONS

The ultrasonographic findings support presence of cruciate ligament edema rather than partial rupture. No overt fiber disruption is seen. Correlation with the clinical palpation is required. Other pathology including patella luxation should be ruled out.

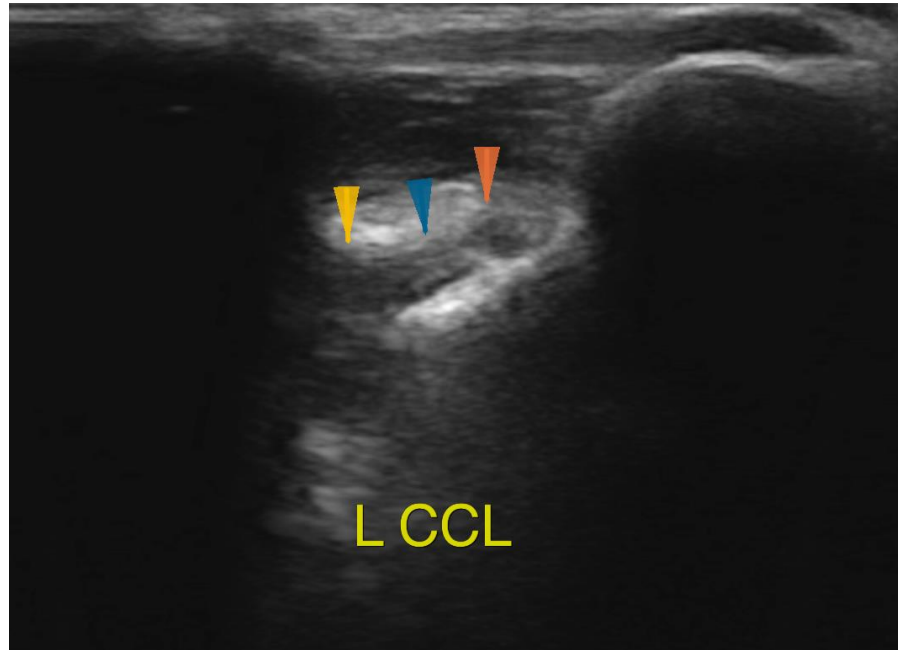
