PRESENTING CLINICAL SIGNS

Milo presented for cyst on upper left lip. This was first noted a month ago and grew rapidly since period. Previous diagnostics were obtained and revealed ~~~. looking for possible metastatic disease.

RADIOGRAPHIC STUDY OF THE THORAX

Right/left lateral and dorsoventral views of the thorax totaling 3 images available for review.

RADIOGRAPHIC FINDINGS

The patient is obese.

The patient is under anesthesia and intubated.

SEX

MN

The degree of pulmonary inflation is fair. A mild generalized bronchointerstitial lung pattern is seen and evenly distributed throughout the lung. No evidence of pulmonary nodules or masses is seen.

AGE

9 Years

There is no evidence of mediastinal widening.

The radiographic presentation of the cardiac silhouette is within normal limits.

No abnormality of the ribcage and other thoracic boundaries is seen.

There is mild generalized enlargement of liver and mild gastric aerophagia.

RADIOGRAPHIC DIAGNOSIS

- No evidence of pulmonary metastatic disease.
- Normal age related lung and bronchial tree.
- Normal radiographic presentation of the cardiac silhouette.
- Mild hepatomegaly.
- Aerophagia.

INTERPRETATION OF THE FINDINGS & FURTHER RECOMMENDATIONS

The radiographic screening was negative for pulmonary nodules or masses. The thoracic findings are considered within age related normal limits.

Mild hepatomegaly was noted and may be due to metabolic / endocrine hepatopathy. Diffuse, inflammatory, or neoplastic infiltrates are thought unlikely but can never be ruled out entirely. Correlate with the blood work.
