RADIOGRAPHIC STUDY OF THE ABDOMEN

BREED Right lateral and ventrodorsal views totaling 2 images provided for review.

Mix **RADIOGRAPHIC FINDINGS**

The surrounding bony structures are within normal limits.

SEX No abnormalities of the extra-abdominal soft tissues are noted. The abdominal wall is smooth and thin.

Spayed Female The serosal detail is maintained throughout the peritoneal and retroperitoneal space.

AGE The liver is appropriate in position and size and presents uniform opacity.

2 Years The splenic head is in the anticipated position and within normal limits for size and opacity. The splenic body and tail are considered normal for position, size, shape, and opacity.

Both kidneys are seen and present with normal size, shape, delineation, and opacity. The urinary bladder is in its anticipated position. No radiopaque calculi are noted throughout the upper and lower urinary tract.

The stomach contains a mild amount of gas. The small intestinal loops are evenly distributed throughout the mid abdomen and are of even diameter. No evidence of abnormal dilation seen. There is no radiopaque foreign material. Some small intestinal loops present a mildly discrepant gas pattern and corrugation. The colon is empty.

- Gastrointestinal maldigestion pattern - No evidence of mechanical ileus or foreign material seen.

INTERPRETATION OF FINDINGS & FURTHER RECOMMENDATIONS

No evidence of mechanical ileus. The findings are suggestive for functional ileus and parallel the history of vomiting and diarrhea. Further definition by means of recheck radiographs or ultrasound is only indicated in case of persisting or deteriorating clinical signs.
