RADIOGRAPHIC STUDY OF THE LUMBAR SPINE

Lateral, ventrodorsal, and ventrodorsal oblique views of the lumbar spine totaling 4 images available for review.

RADIOGRAPHIC FINDINGS

Number, alignment, and anatomy of the lumbar vertebrae present within normal limits.

There is no evidence of abnormal soft tissue swelling of the axial musculature.

SEX

The lumbosacral and thoracolumbar junctions present within normal limits.

MN

No evidence of traumatic osseous injury or vertebral subluxation is seen.

AGE

1.6 Years

The coxofemoral and stifle joints present within normal limits. There is no evidence of sacroiliac joint abnormality.

The pelvic bones are intact.
