PRESENTING CLINICAL SIGNS

Patient presented for general lethargy for the past few days, unknown if pet is vomiting but not as interested in food. Owner does state that they got into a rope toy and unsure if he ate it

RADIOGRAPHIC STUDY OF THE ABDOMEN

Right lateral and ventrodorsal views totaling 3 images available for review.

BREED

RADIOGRAPHIC FINDINGS

The surrounding bony structures are within normal limits.

No abnormalities of the extraabdominal soft tissues are noted. The abdominal wall is smooth and thin.

SEX

The serosal detail is maintained throughout the peritoneal and retroperitoneal space.

AGE

3 Years

The liver is appropriate in position, size and presents uniform opacity.

The splenic head is in the anticipated position and within normal limits for size and opacity. The splenic body is considered normal for position, size, shape and opacity. The splenic tail is prominent.

Both kidneys are seen and present with normal size, shape, delineation and opacity. The urinary bladder is in its anticipated position. No radiopaque calculi are noted throughout the upper and lower urinary tract.

The stomach is in its anticipated position and presents normal content.

The small intestinal loops are of even diameter and non-dilated, a small amount of gas is seen within the small intestinal loops and considered within normal limits.

The colon is seen in the expected position and presents with appropriate content.

INTERPRETATION OF THE FINDINGS & FURTHER RECOMMENDATIONS

The radiographic study of the abdomen is negative for mechanical ileus. No radiopaque foreign material and no intestinal plication is seen. Consider full internal medicine workup. An abdominal ultrasound could be considered in case of persisting gastrointestinal signs.
