Pt came in on 10/20/21 and presented with limping on his L front limb -Owner says that it has been going on for about 2 months. Owner states that it has progressively gotten worse. Owner also stated he is not wanting to eat as much. No coughing. Owner did mention he loves to dig and play in the dirt. Owner also mentioned in room that they have ticks in yard. Pt blood work sent out for VF test and results came back on 10/22/21 as negative. Radiographs were preformed, Doctor suspects possible lysis of the left forelimb but would like consult. Sent out blood panel for tickborne diseases on 10/23/21 (pending results).

**RADIOGRAPHIC STUDY OF THE FOREARMS**

Mediolateral and craniocaudal views of both forearms totaling 4 images available for review.

**RADIOGRAPHIC FINDINGS****SEX**

Male

The radiographic study reveals extensive patchy medullary sclerosis of the diaphyseal portions of the long bones in both front limbs accentuating the left radius.

Prominence of the metaphyseal cutback zones is noted in the distal ulnar in both front limbs.

The elbow and carpal joints present within normal limits.

**INTERPRETATION OF THE FINDINGS & FURTHER RECOMMENDATIONS**

Panosteitis eosinophilica is a noninfectious inflammatory disease of the long bones in growing dogs which is typically self-limiting and ceases with reaching skeletal maturity. Peripheral blood eosinophilia can be found. Treatment may not be necessary, however, in case of lameness and pain, systemic NSAID administration and restriction of the daily caloric intake can be recommended.
