PRESENTING CLINICAL SIGNS

presented with bleeding gums , x-rays looks like either abscess or tumour in mandible , he is not doing well in general , swollen abdomen , fluid? some times coughing also , no vomiting or diarrhea , eats chicken and cat food still awaiting blood results

RADIOGRAPHIC STUDY OF THE HEAD & THORAX

Single right lateral view of the thorax and neck and lateral and dorsoventral views of the head totaling 3 images available for review.

RADIOGRAPHIC FINDINGS

Head

There appears to be mild soft tissue swelling in the left side of the face which, however, may also be due to slightly rotated position of the head in the orthogonal view. Mild soft tissue swelling is seen in the corresponding lateral view caudoventral of the mandibular angle.

AGE

2 Years

There appears to be mild multifocal periodontal space widening around the molar teeth of the mandibles. No evidence of aggressive osteolytic lesions is seen.

Thorax

Course and width of the trachea present within normal limits.

No radiographic evidence of cardiovascular pathology is seen.

The lungs present motion related blur; however, as far as seen, there is no evidence of structural bronchopulmonary pathology.

No evidence of pneumothorax or pleural effusion is seen.

There is no evidence of abnormal mediastinal widening.

RADIOGRAPHIC DIAGNOSIS

- Presumed periodontal disease.
- Potential for soft tissue swelling in the face/mandibular angle.
- Radiographically normal thorax.

INTERPRETATION OF THE FINDINGS & FURTHER RECOMMENDATIONS

No evidence of aggressive osteolytic changes of the mandibles is noted radiographically. Consider the potential of soft tissue injury/inflammation as well as submandibular lymphadenomegaly.

The thoracic study was negative for pleural effusion, congestive heart failure, or structural bronchopulmonary disease.
