RADIOGRAPHIC STUDY OF THE HEAD

Lateral and orthogonal views as well as oblique open mouth views totaling 8 images available for review. Side markers not available.

RADIOGRAPHIC FINDINGS

There appears to be severe bone loss in one maxilla with loosening of the molar and canine teeth. Increased soft tissue opacity is noted in the affected area.

The contralateral maxilla appears to be within normal limits.

RADIOGRAPHIC DIAGNOSIS

- Suspect unilateral aggressive maxillary bone lysis with potential soft tissue mass effect.

INTERPRETATION OF THE FINDINGS & FURTHER RECOMMENDATIONS

The radiographic findings are not finally conclusive and differential diagnosis includes soft tissue neoplasia with aggressive bone lysis, odontogenic neoplasia, as well as severe chronic osteomyelitis. However, there appears to be marked regional bone loss in one of the maxillae with loosening of the teeth in the same alveolar crest. Final diagnosis will require sampling for histology and dental workup which both should be considered if not performed already.
