**PRESENTING CLINICAL SIGNS**

3 days coughing and bloody vomit  
Abnormal PE/Chem/CBC/UA Results: BW unremarkable

**RADIOGRAPHIC STUDY OF THE THORAX & ABDOMEN**

Right/left lateral and ventrodorsal views of the thorax and abdomen each totaling 6 images available for review.

**BREED**

American Bulldog Mix

**RADIOGRAPHIC FINDINGS**

**Thorax**

The degree of pulmonary inflation is fair to moderate. A mild generalized bronchial lung pattern is noted and evenly distributed throughout the lung.

**SEX**

Female Spayed

Course and width of the trachea are considered within normal limits.

There is no evidence of mediastinal widening.

**AGE**

6 Years

The cardiac silhouette presents no evidence of generalized or specific chamber enlargement. The pulmonary vasculature presents within normal limits.

**Abdomen**

The abdominal serosal detail is maintained.

Moderate gastric aerophagia is noted. The position of the stomach is considered within normal limits. No radiopaque foreign material can be seen within the stomach.

The small intestinal loops are evenly distributed throughout the mid abdomen and contain mainly gas. No evidence of abnormal dilation, plication, or radiopaque foreign material is seen.

The cecum contains gas. The colon contains a moderate amount of fecal matter.

No specific cause of the patient's clinical signs can be identified radiographically. The mild bronchial lung pattern may be within age related normal limits. Lower airway disease such as eosinophilic bronchopneumopathy or infectious bronchitis cannot be ruled out.

**DATE**

10-6-22

A gastrointestinal maldigestion pattern with no signs of mechanical ileus is seen. Consider functional ileus in the context of the reported gastroenteropathy a potential. Full internal medicine workup is recommended in order to rule out coagulopathy, systemic infection, or other, as well as full abdominal ultrasound.
