PRESENTING CLINICAL SIGNS

Pet has been limping on R leg off and on since 10/20/21. Sometimes light weight bearing and sometimes completely holding leg off the ground. Has history of bladder cancer for past 2 years and responding well so far.

SPECIES

Abnormal PE/Chem/CBC/UA Results: No limping found during exam. No painful areas found with palpation. Good ROM with no reaction. O reports increasing ALP over past year so more concern of bone cancer issue. ALP values over the past year: 8/12/20 51, 12/1/20, 60, 3/16/21 97, 6/17/21 82, 9/1/21 107

RADIOGRAPHIC STUDY OF THE FRONT LIMBS

Mediolateral views of the shoulders and elbows and craniocaudal views of the elbows and carpi totaling 5 images available for review.

SEX

RADIOGRAPHIC FINDINGS

Rudimentary 1st digits are noted in both front limbs.

There is no evidence of aggressive osteolytic lesions or abnormal soft tissue swelling in the paws.

AGE

11 Years

Mild irregularity in the proximal diaphysis is seen between the radius and ulnar in both front limbs which is coinciding with the anatomic position of the interosseous membrane and a normal finding.

Both elbow joints present within age related normal limits. No evidence of osteoarthritic changes are seen.

Both shoulder present within normal limits as well.

INTERPRETATION OF THE FINDINGS & FURTHER RECOMMENDATIONS

The radiographic study of the front limbs reveals normal radiographic anatomic relationships. There is no evidence of structural pathology in the right front limb that would correlate with the patient's clinical signs. Soft tissue trauma or inflammation as well as neurologic disease including cervical and brachial plexus pathology are potential considerations.
