Dorsopalmar view available for review.

**RADIOGRAPHIC FINDINGS**

The patient has a chondrodystrophic stunted conformation of the long bones with curved radius and shortened ulnar.

**SEX**

Male

There is no evidence of luxation or subluxation in the carpal and metacarpophalangeal joint areas in both front limbs. No abnormal soft tissue swelling is seen. I cannot delineate a fracture of the carpal or metacarpal bones.

**AGE**

9 Months, 2 Weeks

**RADIOGRAPHIC DIAGNOSIS**

- Radiographically normal carpal joints.

**INTERPRETATION OF THE FINDINGS & FURTHER RECOMMENDATIONS**

The radiographic study of the carpal joints and metacarpophalangeal joints reveal no evidence of traumatic osseous injury.
