**RADIOGRAPHIC STUDY OF THE ABDOMEN**
**SPECIES**

Right lateral and ventrodorsal views of the abdomen totaling 3 images available for review.

Canine

**RADIOGRAPHIC FINDINGS**
**BREED**

History of pelvic fractures with a plate and 4 screws in the left os ilium. The fracture is completely healed. Non-union fractures of the pelvic floor are seen.

Mix

The lumbar vertebrae present within normal limits regarding their number, general anatomy, and alignment.

**SEX**

The abdominal serosal detail is maintained.

Mix

The liver and spleen present within normal limits.

**AGE**

The stomach contains a mild amount of gas. Small intestinal loops are evenly distributed throughout the mid abdomen. No evidence of abnormal dilation, plication, or abnormal content. A mild amount of fecal matter is seen within the colon.

**INTERPRETATION OF FINDINGS & FURTHER RECOMMENDATIONS**

The radiographic study of the abdomen does not reveal evidence of reduced serosal detail, abdominal organomegaly, or mass effects. The gastrointestinal tract presents within normal limits. Further definition by means of ultrasound could be considered to rule out gastroenteropathy or pancreatopathy with greater sensitivity.
