PRESENTING CLINICAL SIGNS

History of ehrlichia

SPECIES

Canine

RADIOGRAPHIC FINDINGS**Left Stifle**

Severe articular swelling of the left stifle joint is seen as well as moderate cranial thrust of the tibia and distal displacement of the popliteal sesamoid bone. There is a moderate amount of periarticular osteophytes accentuating the femoral trochlear, distal pole of the patella, tibial plateau, and fabellae.

BREED

Bearded Collie

The popliteal lymph node presents within normal limits.

SEX

Male Neutered

Pelvis

Moderate atrophy of the left hind limb musculature is seen.

Both coxofemoral joints present within normal limits. There is no evidence of osteoarthritis or dysplasia.

AGE

5 Years

RADIOGRAPHIC DIAGNOSIS

- Moderate chronic left stifle osteoarthritis with radiographic evidence of cranial cruciate ligament failure.
- Radiographically normal coxofemoral joints.
- Disuse atrophy of the left hind limb musculature.

INTERPRETATION OF THE FINDINGS & FURTHER RECOMMENDATIONS

The radiographic findings are compatible with failure of the cranial cruciate ligament with moderate left stifle osteoarthritis. Concurrent meniscopathy cannot be ruled out. Consider surgical intervention in order to address the presumed biomechanical instability and prevent further damage to the other articular structures.
