RADIOGRAPHIC STUDY OF THE ABDOMEN

Multiple lateral and ventrodorsal views totaling 9 images available for review.

BREED

Irish Wolfhound Mix

RADIOGRAPHIC FINDINGS

A 2.3 cm sized thin walled cavitory lesion is seen superimposed onto the cardiac silhouette and most likely situated within the caudal subsegment of the left cranial lung lobe.

Multiple moderate to severe thoracolumbar spondyloses and spondylarthroses are seen.

SEX

Moderate gastrointestinal aerophagia is noted. The position of the stomach is considered within normal limits.

There is no evidence of abnormal small intestinal dilation, no plication, or radiopaque foreign material is seen.

AGE

11.4 Years

The colon is largely empty but presents mild spasticity.

RADIOGRAPHIC DIAGNOSIS

- Gastrointestinal maldigestion pattern without radiographic evidence of mechanical ileus.
- Pulmonary bulla.
- Multiple spondyloses and spondylarthroses.

INTERPRETATION OF THE FINDINGS & FURTHER RECOMMENDATIONS

The radiographic study is negative for mechanical ileus. The findings support the presence of functional ileus. Further definition by means of ultrasound could be considered depending on the severity, duration, and development of the clinical signs.
