PRESENTING CLINICAL SIGNS

u/s and rads: rads taken due to recent LH lameness. no drawer sign elicited. growls on hip extension. chem/cbc wnl, anaplasma positive but pcr negative and cbc wnl. also had hematuria and persistent pyuria. prostate enlarged on ultrasound. pet is a 4 yr old ROTW MI.

RADIOGRAPHIC STUDY OF THE LEFT STIFLE & PELVIS

Mediolateral view of the left stifle and ventrodorsal and lateral views of the pelvis totaling 5 images available for review in jpeg format.

BREED

Rottweiler

RADIOGRAPHIC FINDINGS

Severe dysplasia of both coxofemoral joints with poor femoral coverage, flat acetabular grooves, medial joint space divergence, and flattened cranio-lateral acetabular rims is seen. There is lateralized subchondral bone sclerosis. The femoral heads are small. The femoral head centers are lateral of the dorsal acetabular rim. A large amount of circumferential femoral head and caudolateral curvilinear femoral neck osteophytes is seen bilaterally.

SEX

Male

A small ovoid well delineated osseous structure is seen in the attachment of the right gluteal muscles proximal of the greater trochanter of the right femur.

AGE

4 Years

Mild intermuscular emphysema is present in the proximal and lateral right thigh.

The muscle volume of the left hind limb appears to be reduced.

The radiographic presentation of the left stifle joint is within normal limits.

RADIOGRAPHIC DIAGNOSIS

- Moderate bilateral canine hip dysplasia with severe secondary osteoarthritic changes.
- Disuse atrophy of the left hind limb musculature.
- Metaplasia within the right gluteal muscles - incidental finding.
- Radiographically normal left stifle.

INTERPRETATION OF THE FINDINGS & FURTHER RECOMMENDATIONS

The radiographic study reveals severe bilateral coxofemoral joint osteoarthritis as a consequence of bilateral canine hip dysplasia.

The atrophy of the left hind limb musculature indicates chronic disuse of the left hind limb.

No evidence of left stifle arthropathy was found radiographically.
