**PRESENTING CLINICAL SIGNS**

limping on LH , was diagnosed with hip dysplasia , has pain response when manipulating left stifle  
Abnormal PE/Chem/CBC/UA Results: unremarkable

**RADIOGRAPHIC STUDY OF THE STIFLES**

Mediolateral views of both stifles and ventrodorsal view of the pelvis totaling 3 images available for review.

**BREED**

Border Collie

Stifle read requested.

**SEX**

Male Neutered

**RADIOGRAPHIC FINDINGS**

The radiographic presentation of both stifles is within normal limits. No evidence of articular swelling or patella tendon injury is seen.

**AGE**

7 Years

The position of the intercondylar eminence is superimposed onto the mid-point of the femoral condyles which is as expected.

The origin of the gastrocnemius muscle presents within normal limits.

No evidence of osteophytes or enthesophytes is seen.

- Radiographically normal stifles.

**INTERPRETATION OF THE FINDINGS & FURTHER RECOMMENDATIONS**

No evidence of articular or osseous injury of the stifles is seen radiographically. Early stages of musculotendinopathy cannot be ruled out entirely. However, translocated pain from the coxofemoral joints and functional problems due to shifting load in the hind limbs appear to be a potential in this patient.
