PRESENTING CLINICAL SIGNS

P presents for limping and welping in pain starting today. P was running down the stairs, when suddenly P winced in pain. Has happened multiple times today. O did not give any food since the limping started. No vomiting or diarrhea.

RADIOGRAPHIC STUDY OF THE SHOULDERS

Mediolateral and caudocranial views of both shoulders available for review.

RADIOGRAPHIC FINDINGS

Both shoulders appear normal in alignment and bone structure. No evidence of fractures, luxation, or dislocation is seen. Humeral heads, glenoids, and acromions are within normal limits. Joint spaces are preserved. Subchondral bone density is normal. No significant osteophytosis or mineralization is identified. There is no evidence of aggressive bone disease.

Mild intervertebral disc space narrowing is noted at C6/7.

RADIOGRAPHIC DIAGNOSIS

- Normal radiographic appearance of both shoulders with no acute osseous or joint abnormalities identified.
- Mild disc space narrowing consistent with disc disease C6/7.

INTERPRETATION OF FINDINGS & FURTHER RECOMMENDATIONS

The acute limping is not explained by radiographic shoulder abnormalities. Consider soft tissue injury or inflammation or acute disc related pain as potential sources. Orthopedic and/or neurologic evaluation may be warranted if pain persists including follow up imaging depending on the clinical signs and potential presence of neurologic deficits.
