Ventrodorsal hip extended view of the pelvis and mediolateral and craniocaudal views of the right stifle totaling 3 images available for review in jpeg format.

**RADIOGRAPHIC FINDINGS**

The muscle volume appears to be mildly reduced in the right hind limb. However, at least part of this may be positional.

**AGE**

6 Years

The coxofemoral joints present within age related normal limits. No evidence of dysplasia or osteoarthritis is seen.

The radiographic presentation of the right and left stifle is within normal limits as well. There are no signs of articular enlargement, osteoarthritis, and no evidence of aggressive bone disease is seen.

- Radiographically normal coxofemoral and right stifle joints.

**INTERPRETATION OF THE FINDINGS & FURTHER RECOMMENDATIONS**

The radiographic study does not reveal structural pathology in the right stifle nor in the hip joints. Lameness of other origin including soft tissue trauma or inflammation as well as neurologic disease can be potential considerations in this patient.
