Lateral and ventrodorsal views of the pelvis including lateral views of the stifles totaling 3 images available for review.

RADIOGRAPHIC FINDINGS

Remnants of positive contrast media are seen in the stomach.

SEX

M

Number, alignment, anatomy, and osseous maturity of the lumbar vertebrae and sacrum present within normal limits.

No overt signs of canine hip dysplasia are seen. The femoral heads appear to be well covered.

AGE

13 Weeks

The muscle volume of both hind limbs is low.

No structural pathology of the stifle joints and no articular swelling are seen.

RADIOGRAPHIC DIAGNOSIS

- Normal age related findings of the lumbar spine, pelvis, and stifle joints.
- Low muscle volume.

INTERPRETATION OF THE FINDINGS & FURTHER RECOMMENDATIONS

The radiographic study reveals no evidence of stifle or coxofemoral joint arthropathy. Skeletal maturity appears to be appropriate for the patient's age. Consider neurologic disease such as neuromuscular pathology and neurodegenerative disease as well as inflammatory/infectious diseases a potential.

The muscle atrophy may be secondary to disuse or neurogenic.
