PRESENTING CLINICAL SIGNS

Nuala is 9 year old spayed Great Pyrenees mix that has been presented with history of hematuria and straining to urinate on and off over the last week. Bloodwork, urinalyses and urine culture were unremarkable. Just RBC in urine.

SPECIES

Canine

RADIOGRAPHIC STUDY OF THE CAUDAL ABDOMEN

2 right lateral and 1 ventrodorsal image totaling 3 images available for review.

BREED

Great Pyrenees Mix

RADIOGRAPHIC FINDINGS

The patient is obese.

Severe bilateral coxofemoral joint osteoarthritis is seen.

SEX

Spayed Female

The radiographic presentation of the caudal abdomen is within normal limits.

The urinary bladder is mildly distended. No evidence of abnormal opacities and no mass effects are seen.

AGE

9 Years

There is no radiographic evidence of sublumbar mass effects.

RADIOGRAPHIC DIAGNOSIS

- Normal radiographic presentation of the lower urinary tract.
- Severe bilateral coxofemoral joint osteoarthritis secondary to hip dysplasia - unrelated to the reason of clinical presentation.

INTERPRETATION OF THE FINDINGS & FURTHER RECOMMENDATIONS

The radiographic study of the caudal abdomen is within normal limits. The urinary bladder is mildly distended. Owing to the patient history and demographics, further definition by means of abdominal ultrasound is strongly recommended in order to rule out neoplastic disease as underlying cause of the clinical signs and to further assess for other potential differential diagnoses.
