



**PATIENT PRESENTING CLINICAL SIGNS**

Sheba Blade 3/16/22 Cat anemic & high WBC 37,000. Treated with Clav but after 5 days cat got diarrhea. Mid-abd mass palpable. Hyporexia. 2/25/22 abd US very large spleen. Chest rads taken for mets.

**SPECIES RADIOGRAPHIC STUDY OF THE THORAX**

Feline Right/left lateral and ventrodorsal whole body views totaling 3 images available for review.

Thoracic read requested.

**BREED RADIOGRAPHIC FINDINGS**

DSH

The degree of pulmonary inflation is fair. A moderate generalized bronchial lung pattern with peribronchial cuffing is seen. Dystelectasis of the cranial lung lobes is noted. No evidence of pulmonary nodules or masses is seen.

**SEX**

Female Spayed

Course and width of the trachea are considered within normal limits.

The cardiac silhouette is small. Pulmonary vasculature and caudal vena cava are small.

**AGE**

12 Years

There is no evidence of mediastinal lymphadenomegaly or other mediastinal widening.

- Lower airway pattern.
- No evidence of pulmonary metastatic disease.
- Partial dystelectasis of the cranial lung lobes.
- Hypovolemia with microcardia and underperfusion of the lung.

**INTERPRETATION OF THE FINDINGS & FURTHER RECOMMENDATIONS**

The radiographic screening is negative for pulmonary metastatic disease. A lower airway pattern is noted which may not necessarily be of clinical significance at this point. However, the changes suggest presence of chronic lower airway changes which may be associated with allergic lower airway syndrome or infectious bronchitis such as viral, bacterial, and less likely parasitic, or protozoal. Further workup of the bronchopulmonary changes should be considered in case of pertinent clinical signs.
