Right/left lateral and ventrodorsal views totaling 4 images available for review.

RADIOGRAPHIC FINDINGS

A moderate diffuse bronchoalveolar lung pattern with peribronchial cuffing with cranioventral and left sided accentuation is seen.

SEX

The pulmonary vasculature and cardiac silhouette present within normal limits. The vertebral heart score is 8.4.

Course and width of the trachea are considered within normal limits.

The thoracic boundaries present within normal limits.

AGE

14 Years

RADIOGRAPHIC DIAGNOSIS

- Moderate bronchoalveolar lung pattern with asymmetric distribution and ventral accentuation.
- No radiographic evidence of cardiovascular pathology.

INTERPRETATION OF THE FINDINGS & FURTHER RECOMMENDATIONS

The radiographic study reveals a cranioventrally accentuated bronchoalveolar lung pattern. Differential diagnosis includes bronchopneumonia such as infectious including viral, bacterial, and less likely parasitic, eosinophilic bronchopneumopathy. The possibility of acute respiratory distress and systemic inflammatory response should be considered as well even though less likely.
