PRESENTING CLINICAL SIGNS

Pet is jumping on both hindlimbs and walking on hindlimb

SPECIES

Canine

RADIOGRAPHIC STUDY OF THE PELVIS & STIFLES

Ventrodorsal hip extended view of the pelvis with craniocaudal views of the stifles and tarsi, mediolateral view of the right stifle, mediolateral view of one tarsus, and dorsoplantar view of both tarsi totaling 6 images available for review.

BREED

Mini Pinscher

RADIOGRAPHIC FINDINGS

The osseous anatomy of the tarsi presents within normal limits.

The right stifle joint presents within normal limits.

SEX

Female

The patellae are in situ in both stifles. There is no evidence of articular swelling, subchondral bone defects, or cranial thrust of the tibia.

The muscle volume of both hind limbs is adequate and symmetric.

AGE

The coxofemoral joints present no evidence of dysplasia osteoarthritis or other structural injury.

The pelvic bones present the expected radiographic anatomy.

RADIOGRAPHIC DIAGNOSIS

- Radiographically normal pelvis, stifles, and tarsi.

INTERPRETATION OF THE FINDINGS & FURTHER RECOMMENDATIONS

The radiographic presentation of the pelvis, coxofemoral joints, stifle joints, and tarsal joints is within age related normal limits. No evidence of osseous or articular injury is identified. Consider soft tissue trauma or inflammation as well as neurologic disease.
