Lateral and ventrodorsal views of the thorax and abdomen totaling 5 images available for review.

RADIOGRAPHIC FINDINGS

Thorax

The patient is in thin body condition.

SEX

Subcutaneous soft tissue swelling with multiple linear and round gas inclusions is seen in the dorsum.

MN

The degree of pulmonary inflation is deep. A mild generalized bronchial lung pattern is seen.

AGE

16 Years

The radiographic presentation of the cardiac silhouette is within normal limits.

Course and width of the trachea are within normal limits.

Abdomen

The abdominal serosal detail is maintained.

The stomach is distended with a large amount of fluid and gas. A mild amount of gravel is seen in the stomach as well.

The small intestinal loops present a gas pattern with no evidence of segmental dilation. A mild amount of gravel is seen in the nondilated small intestine.

The colon contains a moderate amount of fecal matter.

RADIOGRAPHIC DIAGNOSIS

- Gastric distension.
- Functional ileus pattern.
- Iatrogenic emphysema and subcutaneous soft tissue swelling.

INTERPRETATION OF THE FINDINGS & FURTHER RECOMMENDATIONS

The radiographic study suggests potential for delayed gastric emptying and functional intestinal ileus. Primary gastroenteropathy including gastroenteritis and triaditis is a potential underlying cause as well as pancreatopathy, hepatopathy, and systemic disease. No definitive obstructive ileus is seen. If not performed already, abdominal ultrasound is strongly recommended in this patient in order to further define the source of the ileus.
