PRESENTING CLINICAL SIGNS

Inappropriate urination Right leg diffuse swelling
Abnormal PE/Chem/CBC/UA Results: Hx of Stage IV renal failure Wondering what the cause of the soft tissue swelling is in the RF leg

SPECIES

RADIOGRAPHIC STUDY OF THE RIGHT FRONT LIMB

Mediolateral and craniocaudal views of the right forearm totaling 3 images available for review.

BREED

DMH

RADIOGRAPHIC FINDINGS

No osseous nor articular abnormality can be identified in the right front limb.

The phalangeal, metacarpophalangeal, carpal, and elbow joints all present within normal limits.

SEX

MN

Moderate diffuse swelling of the soft tissues is seen circumferential to the right front paw and right forearm starting from the level of the right elbow. There is diffuse loss of the outline of the fascial planes. No evidence of radiopaque foreign material is noted in the swollen soft tissues.

AGE

21 Years

The soft tissues and bones of the left front limb present within normal limits.

RADIOGRAPHIC DIAGNOSIS

- Soft tissue pathology with extensive generalized swelling of the right front limb distal to the elbow with no evidence of osseous involvement.

INTERPRETATION OF THE FINDINGS & FURTHER RECOMMENDATIONS

The radiographic findings are unspecific. Sterile and septic cellulitis/compartment syndrome are considered a potential as well as hematoma and lymphedema which, however, are less likely. Screen for superficial soft tissue injury and consider sampling for further definition.
