



PATIENT PRESENTING CLINICAL SIGNS

Milo Dachisen Intermittent lameness Left Rear leg. No Abnormalities palpated : no luxating patella ; muscle atrophy Left ear leg.

SPECIES RADIOGRAPHIC STUDY OF THE STIFLES & PELVIS

Canine Ventrodorsal hip extended view of the pelvis and mediolateral views of both stifles totaling 4 images available for review.

BREED RADIOGRAPHIC FINDINGS

Beagle **Stifles**

The radiographic presentation of both stifles is within normal limits. No evidence of articular swelling, tibial thrust, patella luxation, subchondral bone defects, or osteophytes is seen.

SEX

MN **Pelvis**

The patient is obese.

AGE

3 Years No significant muscle volume loss can be appreciated radiographically.

The coxofemoral joints present within age and breed related normal limits. No significant signs of laxity or osteoarthritis are seen.

INTERPRETATION OF THE FINDINGS & FURTHER RECOMMENDATIONS

The source of the lameness remains unclear based on the radiographic findings of the pelvis and stifles. There is no radiographic evidence of stifle arthropathy or coxofemoral joint disease. No significant muscle atrophy is appreciated. Consider lameness of other origin including soft tissue trauma or inflammation as well as neurologic disease.
