Outdoor pet, presented for not doing well, not putting much weight on Left rear limb. Tx'd w antibiotics and NSAID's which helped but now symptoms returned.
Abnormal PE/Chem/CBC/UA Results: Swollen Left hock, popliteal lymph node

SPECIES COMPUTED TOMOGRAPHIC STUDY OF THE TARSAL JOINTS

Feline Plain and post contrast studies available for review.

COMPUTED TOMOGRAPHIC FINDINGS**BREED**

DSH

Moderate articular swelling of the left tibiotarsal joint is seen. The synovium of the left tibiotarsal joint presents moderate generalized thickening with increased contrast enhancement. The plantar and dorsal joint recesses are moderately distended and filled with fluid attenuating contrast negative material.

SEX

Intact Male

At this point, no evidence of subchondral bone erosion is seen. There is no evidence of traumatic osseous injury, articular luxation, or subluxation. The tarsal bones are in situ and intact.

Mild intertarsal joint effusion is present.

AGE

10 Months

The left popliteal lymph node presents moderate symmetric enlargement and measures 2 x 1 cm. Mild nonuniform contrast enhancement is noted.

COMPUTED TOMOGRAPHIC DIAGNOSIS**INTERPRETED BY**Nele Eley (Ondreka),

- Nonerosive arthropathy of the left tibiotarsal and intertarsal joint with extensive articular effusion.
- Moderate left popliteal lymphadenomegaly.

INTERPRETATION OF FINDINGS & FURTHER RECOMMENDATIONS**HOSPITAL NAME**

Mobile Pet Imaging

Differential diagnosis includes arthritis such as sterile or septic and less likely traumatic joint effusion. Further definition by means of aspiration and analysis of the left tibiotarsal joint synovia is strongly recommended if not performed already. Moreover, fine needle aspiration of the left popliteal lymph node should be considered. The lymph node changes are likely to represent reactive or suppurative lymphadenitis. Infiltrative disease is thought unlikely.
