RADIOGRAPHIC FINDINGS

The abdominal serosal detail is reduced in the center of the abdomen with patchy to granulated appearance of the peritoneal fat.

AGE

The small intestinal loops are turgid in appearance. Multiple gas bubbles are seen within the small intestinal lumen. No evidence of abnormal dilation, plication, or radiopaque foreign material can be identified.

The stomach appears to be contracted with no abnormal content or malpositioning being visible. No evidence of a soft tissue mass is seen.

RADIOGRAPHIC DIAGNOSIS

- Reduced peritoneal detail.
- Gastrointestinal maldigestion pattern.

INTERPRETATION OF THE FINDINGS & FURTHER RECOMMENDATIONS

The radiographic study reveals reduced serosal detail accentuating the center of the abdomen. Consider peritonitis versus smaller amounts of peritoneal fluid a potential, and further definition by means of ultrasound is strongly recommended if not performed already to further define the cause of the radiographic findings.
