**SPECIES LIMITED ULTRASONOGRAPHIC STUDY**

**SPECIES** Canine  
 Moderate bilateral anechoic stifle joint effusion, moderate synovial swelling, and a mild to moderate amount of periarticular osteophytes noted, left more than right. The visible parts of the menisci present within normal limits. The cranial cruciate ligaments are not included in the views.

**BREED** American Bull Terrier  
 • Mild to moderate bilateral stifle osteoarthritis

**SEX INTERPRETATION OF FINDINGS & FURTHER RECOMMENDATIONS**

**SEX** Spayed Female  
 The ultrasonographic study reveals bilateral stifle osteoarthritis. The changes are typical for what is commonly represented concurrently to cranial cruciate ligament injury. However, primary degenerative joint disease and inflammatory arthropathy cannot be ruled out entirely as differential diagnoses.
