RADIOGRAPHIC STUDY OF THE STIFLES

Mediolateral and craniocaudal views of the stifles totaling 6 images available for review in jpeg format.

BREED

Bichon Frise

RADIOGRAPHIC FINDINGS

The exposure is not for the soft tissue and with this exposure, no articular swelling can be identified. However, the right stifle presents mild smooth new bone formation at the margins of the femoral trochlea. The patella is in situ. There is no overt cranial thrust of the tibia.

SEX

Neutered Male

The left stifle presents within normal limits.

Mild atrophy of the right hind limb musculature is noted.

The coxofemoral joints present within normal limits.

AGE

- Mild right stifle osteoarthritis.
- Mild disuse atrophy of the right hind limb musculature.

INTERPRETATION OF THE FINDINGS & FURTHER RECOMMENDATIONS

The radiographic study reveals mild right stifle osteoarthritis. The volume loss of the right hind limb's musculature is mild and indicates presumed longer standing disuse. Correlate with the clinical palpation in order to determine the potential presence of patella luxation or tibial thrust since patella luxation and cranial cruciate ligament injury are the most common underlying causes of the pertinent radiographic changes. However, other arthropathy including traumatic, degenerative, immune mediated, and meniscal injury cannot be ruled out.
