PRESENTING CLINICAL SIGNS

Sunshine will hold up the LH leg, and hears a clicking sound when adjusted. Grade I-II patellar luxation of the LEFT stifle.

SPECIES

Canine

RADIOGRAPHIC STUDY OF THE STIFLES

Mediolateral and craniocaudal views of both stifles totaling 5 images available for review.

BREED

Italian Greyhound

RADIOGRAPHIC FINDINGS

The patellae are in situ at the time of the radiographic examination. One of the craniocaudal views of the left stifle is overpronated with the patella being projected medial to the intercondylar fossa which, however, appears to be within the limits of the pronation and hence, positional.

SEX

FS

Minimal articular swelling of both stifle joints may be present; however, the infrapatellar fat bodies are still well seen.

There is no evidence of periarticular osteophytes. No cranial thrust of the tibia is noted.

AGE

1 Year

There is no evidence of angular limb deformity.

The popliteal lymph nodes present within normal limits.

RADIOGRAPHIC DIAGNOSIS

- Normal radiographic presentation of the stifles.

INTERPRETATION OF THE FINDINGS & FURTHER RECOMMENDATIONS

The radiographic examination of the stifles is within normal limits. Grade 1 or 2 patella luxation remains a potential. No angular limb deformity is seen. At this time, there is no significant articular swelling or osteoarthritis noted radiographically.
