PRESENTING CLINICAL SIGNS

Pain on extension of left elbow. Intermittent lameness.

SPECIES

Canine

RADIOGRAPHIC STUDY OF THE LEFT ELBOW

Mediolateral and craniocaudal views of the left elbow totaling 3 images available for review.

BREED

Yorkshire Terrier

The muscle volume of the left front limb appears to be reduced.

The elbow joint surfaces are congruent. No evidence of osteoarthritic changes is seen. The medial coronoid process is not seen well which is likely a function of the positioning and pronation.

RADIOGRAPHIC DIAGNOSIS

- Normal radiographic presentation of the left elbow.
- Suspect muscle atrophy in the left front limb.

INTERPRETATION OF THE FINDINGS & FURTHER RECOMMENDATIONS

No structural changes of the left elbow were identified radiographically that would explain the clinical lameness in this patient. There appears to be atrophy of the left front limb musculature which may be secondary to disuse or neurogenic. Consider lameness of other origin such as soft tissue trauma or inflammation as well as neurologic disease including cervical, spinal, and peripheral neuropathy.
