PRESENTING CLINICAL SIGNS

Dx with pneumonia , alveolar pattern right middle lung lobe, at local ER. Treated for pneumonia with doxycycline for two weeks. Symptoms resolved within days of treatment. Finished last dose of doxycycline sunday. PE unremarkable.

RADIOGRAPHIC FINDINGS

The degree of pulmonary inflation is moderate. A mild generalized bronchointerstitial lung pattern is seen. There is no evidence of residual alveolar infiltrates. The cranioventral lung is well aerated with no evidence of deviation of air from the pulmonary alveolus.

AGE

8 Months

No evidence of pleural effusion or mediastinal lymphadenomegaly is seen.

The presentation of the cardiac silhouette is considered within normal limits.

Course and width of the trachea are considered within normal limits.

The stomach is postprandial.

RADIOGRAPHIC DIAGNOSIS

- Mild residual bronchointerstitial lung pattern – otherwise, normal age related lung.

INTERPRETATION OF THE FINDINGS & FURTHER RECOMMENDATIONS

The reported alveolar infiltrate has cleared from the lung completely. A mild bronchointerstitial lung pattern is present which may well be a residual of the prior infection and is not necessarily of any clinical significance. Clinical and radiographic recheck would be indicated in case of recurring clinical signs only.
