COMPUTED TOMOGRAPHIC STUDY OF THE THORAX & ABDOMEN

Plain and post contrast studies in soft tissue, lung, and bone windows available for review.

COMPUTED TOMOGRAPHIC FINDINGS

SEX

Male Neutered

Thorax

The bony and surrounding soft tissue structures are within normal limits.

AGE

The sternal, cranial mediastinal and tracheobronchial lymph nodes are small elongated with a normal short-to-long-axis-ratio is < 0.5, the attenuation and contrast enhancement pattern are uniform and considered within normal limits.

The cardiovascular structures including the pulmonary vasculature are within normal limits.

The bronchial tree presents with regular branching and tapers uniformly towards the periphery as expected, the bronchial walls are thin and smooth. The bronchus-to-artery ratio is within normal limits.

The lung parenchyma presents the expected architecture and attenuation behavior.

HOSPITAL NAME

Small incidental gas pockets are seen within the esophageal lumen, there is no evidence of abnormal dilation.

Abdomen

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The serosal fat presents normal attenuation behavior. There is no evidence of peritoneal effusion or peritonitis.

Both kidneys present within normal limits for size, shape and organ architecture. After contrast administration a bilaterally symmetric and uniform nephro- and pyelogram is noted.

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The adrenal glands are within normal limits for size, shape and organ architecture.

Both liver and spleen present with normal shape, even surface, uniformly attenuating parenchyma and homogeneous contrast enhancement, unremarkable. The portal vein presents the expected anatomy and branching. No evidence of extra- or intra- hepatic portosystemic collaterals is seen.

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The pancreas is evenly contoured, the pancreatic parenchyma is homogeneous and presents uniform contrast enhancement.

The position, delineation, wall and content of the gastrointestinal tract are considered within normal limits throughout.

The bony and surrounding soft tissue structures reveal no abnormalities.

BREED

English Sheepdog x
Poodle

- Structurally normal CT findings of the thorax and abdomen.

INTERPRETATION OF THE FINDINGS & FURTHER RECOMMENDATIONS

No structural hepatic pathology is noted. The extra- and intra- hepatic portal venous anatomy present within normal limits. The CT presentation of the gastrointestinal tract and pancreas are within normal limits.

SEX

Male Neutered

Note that diffuse parenchymal liver disease and diffuse infiltrative pathology of the intestinal wall can never be ruled out entirely and sampling for histology could be considered depending on the clinical context and laboratory changes.
